Everyone on the coursing field knew Bayreen – she barked the entire time, waiting her turn to course, as well as coursing on the field. In her short coursing career or 3.5 years, she accomplished everything Terry and I dreamed of. Not only did Bayreen make many coursing friends, so did we.
