The grass is finally getting green and some flowers are appearing. Maybe there will really be a spring! Looking forward to many field trial.

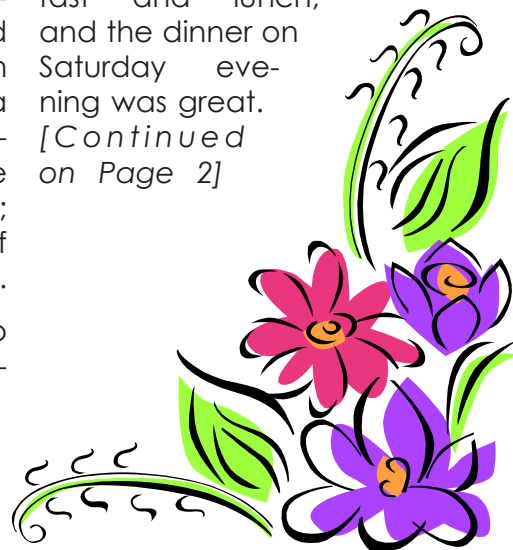

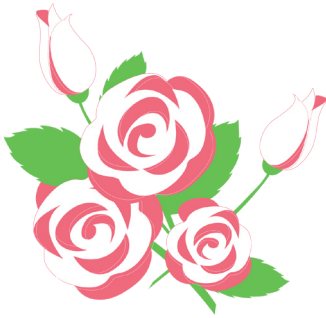
## 2014 International Invitational

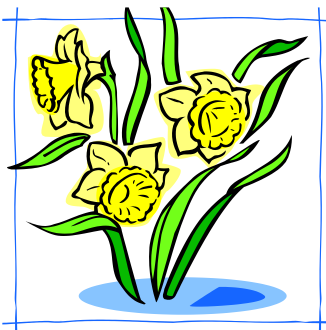
