**ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRATION:**

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or Singles Stake. Limited breeds may be entered in Limited Stake or Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP and PAL), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

Late, incomplete, unsigned or conditional entries will not be accepted. Entries will **NOT** be acknowledged by mail. Preliminary courses for all breeds will be completed before beginning final courses.

**REGULAR STAKES OFFERED:**

**OPEN STAKE:** Any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

**FIELD CHAMPION STAKE:** Any ASFA Field Champion of record

**VETERAN STAKE:** Any eligible sighthound whose age is at least six years and that has met certification requirements, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Afghans, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, and Whippets whose age shall be at least seven years. Points go toward V-FCH and V-LCM titles.

**LIMITED STAKE:** Any eligible sighthound of a Limited breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

**SINGLES STAKE:** Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP & CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

All hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited Stakes for the first time MUST include a completed ASFA certification form or waiver form and a copy of the hound's registration certificate (registration is not required for NGA Greyounds ONLY; certification or waiver is not required for Singles stake entries ONLY).

**BEST IN FIELD WILL BE OFFERED ON SATURDAY ONLY.**

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

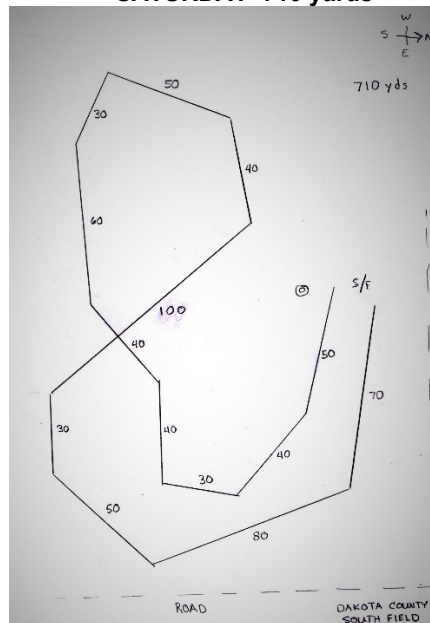
Hounds must be one year of age or older on day of trial. • Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more. • Bitches in season, lame hounds, and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. • Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter, except in Singles Stake. • Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. • All Hounds will be run twice in trios if possible, or braces (except in the Singles Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.

**EQUIPMENT:** Battery powered continuous loop lure machine will be used; backup equipment will be available. Lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.

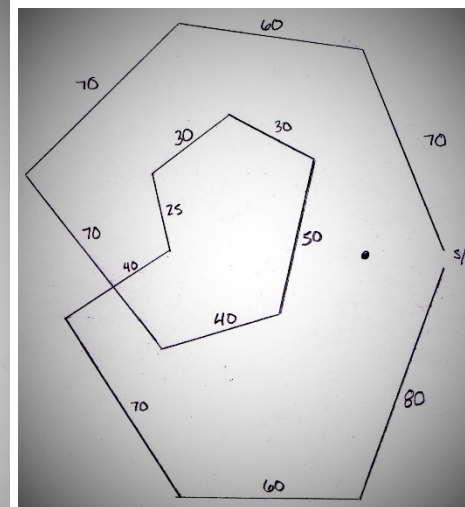
MCA provides slip leads and blankets.

You can make a difference, even if you can help out for an hour or so. Easy ways to volunteer at a lure coursing field trial (and you don't even have to be a T&HLC member):

#### Field Setup

- Come early (one hour before roll call) and start by carrying equipment.
- Learn as you go how to place pulleys and tie downs, eventually

#### Field Clerk

- Volunteer to help the field clerk for even one or two breeds
- Learn how scores are tabulated and recorded - when you are comfortable with this you will be able to start helping the field trial
- secretary.

#### Runner

- Volunteer to run paperwork from the field clerk to the field trial secretary after each breed has run.
- Scores can only be posted as quickly as the paperwork is delivered to the field trial secretary.

#### Lure Operator

- Hang around and talk to the lure operator between courses
- If you are interested, try running the lure around before the
- trial, at lunch or after the trial at practice.

#### Practice

- Give the volunteers who have been working all day a break!
- Take the practice list, call out the names and collect the money.

#### Fundraiser

- It's great when people donate things, but even better if you can
- organize and execute a fundraiser whether it be a 50/50 draw, silent auction, raffle etc. It doesn't have to be complicated or too time consuming.
- Feel free to do this at any MCA trial!

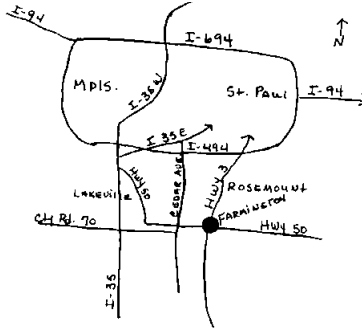
## ACCOMMODATIONS
