Breeds & Eligibility: Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes.. Limited breeds may be entered in Limited Stake or Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP and PAL), the UKC, the NGA, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

Late, incomplete, unsigned or conditional entries will not be accepted. Entries will **NOT** be acknowledged by mail. Preliminary courses for all breeds will be completed before beginning final courses.

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED:

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.
FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion of record
VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound whose age is at least six years and that has met certification requirements, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Afghans, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, and Whippets whose age shall be at least seven years. Points go toward V-FCH and V-LCM titles.
LIMITED STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.
SINGLES STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP & CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

All hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited Stakes for the first time MUST include a completed ASFA certification form or waiver form and a copy of the hound's registration certificate (registration is not required for NGA Greyounds ONLY; certification or waiver is not required for Singles stake entries ONLY).

No Best in Field, but Best in Event on Sunday: Best of Breed winners from both Saturday and Sunday that ran both days without scratches or forfeits are eligible to compete for the Minnesota Cup. The Minnesota Cup will be run following BOB run-offs on Sunday.

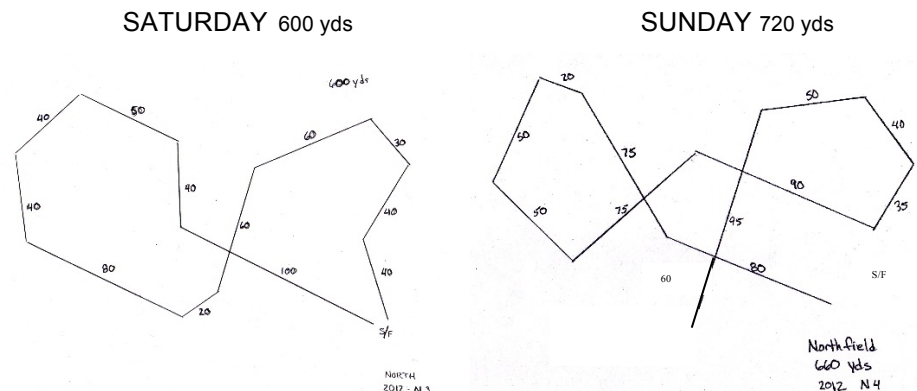
CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Hounds must be one year of age or older on day of trial. • Regular stakes will be split into flights by random public draw if 20 or more entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw • Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame dogs will be excused • Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the singles stake • All Hounds will be run twice in trios if possible, or braces, except in the Singles stake, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified • Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched.

- Hound certification runs will be offered after the trial on Saturday only.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.
- Battery powered continuous loop lure machine will be used; backup equipment will be available.
- Lure will consist of plastic.
- The MCA provides slip leads and blankets.

COURSE PLANS: Reversed for finals. See below.

The MCA reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial. Terrain is grassy.

Field Clerk

- Learn how scores are tabulated and recorded - when you are comfortable with this you will be able to start helping the field trial
- secretary.

Runner

- Volunteer to run paperwork from the field clerk to the field trial secretary after each breed has run.
- Scores can only be posted as quickly as the paperwork is delivered to the field trial secretary.

- trial, at lunch or after the trial at practice.

Practice

- Give the volunteers who have been working all day a break!
- Take the practice list, call out the names and collect the money.

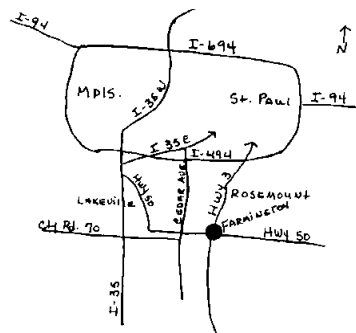

The Nitro Trophy was donated to the MCA by the friends of Nitro. Nitro was ranked # 13 in the ASFA top twenty in 1998, and the #6 whippet in 1999. He was only 63 points away from his LCM 4. Nitro will be best remembered for his great endurance and his ability to turn on a dime.
