- ◆ **Certifications will be offered BEFORE the trial and will begin at 10:15 a.m. No certifications will be offered after the trial. A \$10 fee is applicable per run.**
- ◆ Fun Runs or Practice Runs will be offered **ON SATURDAY ONLY** as conditions allow. .Please notify the FTS that you would like to fun run your hound(s). Please work with us and we will work with you to fit you into the schedule.
- ◆ **ALL PERSONS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR HOUNDS.** The facility and our fellow competitors deserve our respect. If your hound makes a mess, you **MUST** clean it up. *Please report violations to the Field Chair.*
- ◆ A **penalty of \$5.00** will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in progress.
- ◆ A **return check fee of \$35.00** will be assessed for any check returned due to insufficient funds.
- ◆ An electrical-powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used with back-up equipment available.
- ◆ The lure will consist of light colored plastic and/or fur.
- ◆ Muzzles are not required. It is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hounds should be muzzled. If a muzzle is used, it must be of a color other than yellow, pink or blue
- ◆ Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to ASFA, CdECA, any hound, and/or other individual(s) will be asked to leave the trial site
- ◆ This event site has restroom facilities. Water for your hounds also is available. Please bring your own shade and/or shelter
- ◆ Food vendors are not pre-arranged for this event site; however, restaurants are in close proximity in Cat Spring and Bellville. Please plan to “run to lunch” or bring a sack lunch with you.

DIRECTIONS

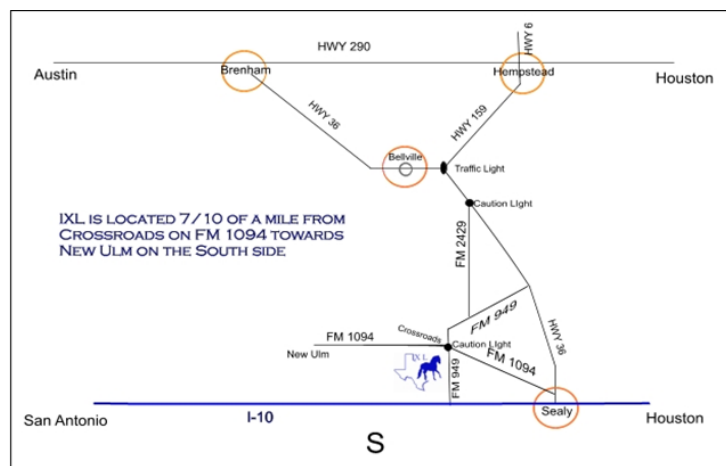
FROM HOUSTON: Take Interstate 10 and head west toward San Antonio. Exit at #720 or Highway 36 and turn north (left) on Texas 36. At the third traffic light (FM 1094) turn left (west) and travel 11 miles. At the corner of FM 949 (blinking light) continue on FM 1094 past the long white PVC fence on the left (do not turn in at the fancy entrance between the PVC fencing); take the 2nd entrance past the PVC at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.

FROM HEMPSTEAD: Take Highway 159 to Bellville. Turn South on Hwy 36 (left). Turn right on FM 2429 at the Exxon station (first blinking light); when you come to the stop sign (FM 949), turn right. On the corner of FM 949 and FM 1094 is a blinking stop light and the Crossroad Tavern. Turn right and travel past the long white PVC fence on the left (do not turn in at the fancy entrance between the PVC fencing); take the 2nd entrance past the PVC at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.

FROM SAN ANTONIO: Take Interstate 10 and head east toward Houston. At FM 949 exit and take a left on the overpass—then take a left on the feeder heading west—take a sharp right on FM 949. Go thru Cat Spring, at the stop sign/blinking light (corner of FM 949 and FM 1094) go left 7/10 of a mile, continue on FM 1094 past the long white PVC fence on the left (do not turn in at the fancy entrance between the PVC fencing); take the 2nd entrance past the PVC at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.

FROM BRENHAM: Take Highway 36 to Bellville. Turn South on Hwy 36 (right). Turn right on FM 2429 at the Exxon station (first blinking light); when you come to the stop sign (FM 949), turn right. On the corner of FM 949 and FM 1094 is the Crossroad Tavern. Turn right and 7/10 of a mile on FM 1094 past the long white PVC fence on the left (do not turn in at the fancy entrance between the PVC fencing); take the 2nd entrance past the PVC at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.

INSPECTION WILL COINCIDE WITH ROLL CALL

All hounds to be inspected for entry in the trial must be presented WITHOUT TAPE, BANDAGES or WRAPPING on the toes, feet, or legs
No pajamas, coats or blankets may be worn by hounds while being inspected

CdECA Members, Field Committee Members and Volunteer Trial Workers may have their hounds inspected at 9:45 a.m. by the full inspection committee

- ◆ Late, conditional, unsigned, incomplete or unpaid entries will not be accepted.
- ◆ Early Entries will not be acknowledged by mail. Entries will be acknowledged by e-mail if requested and if an e-mail address is provided.
- ◆ Substitutions may be made for hounds lame or in season **at the time of roll call.**
- ◆ Entries shall be refused for First Time Entered Hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited Stakes that do not have a copy of registration papers (NGA Greyhounds excepted) to accompany a completed, signed and approved certification form. If a hound has earned a title that waives the certification requirement, a copy of that title certificate must accompany the appropriate ASFA form of waiver
- ◆ Hounds may enter the SINGLES stake without having ASFA certification, but must provide a copy of their official registration papers
- ◆ **Best In Specialty, a non-Regular run on Sunday, will be offered. Best In Specialty will be determined by the Best of Breed winner from both AKC and ASFA Best of Breed winners from both Saturday and Sunday.**

GENERAL INFORMATION/CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

- ◆ All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- ◆ Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.
- ◆ Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused.
- ◆ Monorchid, cryptorchid, spayed, or neutered hounds may be entered.
- ◆ Hounds with breed disqualification are not eligible to enter except in the Single stake.
- ◆ Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched and entry fees will not be refunded.
- ◆ Early entry fees submitted and accepted with early entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for early entries. Requests may be made by time-stamped email to the FTS or by direct contact (phone or in person) with the FTS. No refunds for early entry fees will be returned after the closing of early-entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season
- ◆ Day-of-trial-entry fees submitted and accepted with day-of-trial-entries will be refunded in full if the withdrawal of said entries is requested by the hound's owner or agent prior to the closing deadline for day-of-trial entries. Requests must be made in person to the FTS. No refunds for day-of-trial entry fees will be returned after the closing of day-of-trial entries unless the entered hound upon inspection is lame or in season
- ◆ All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.

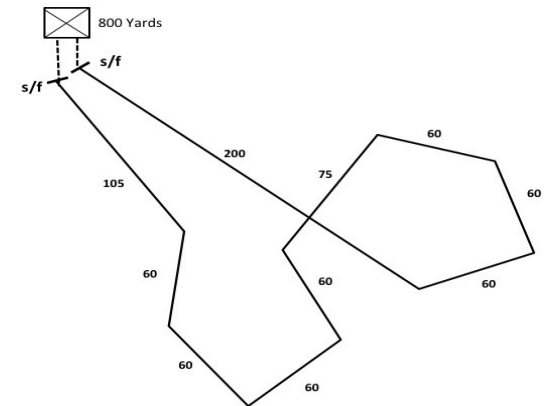

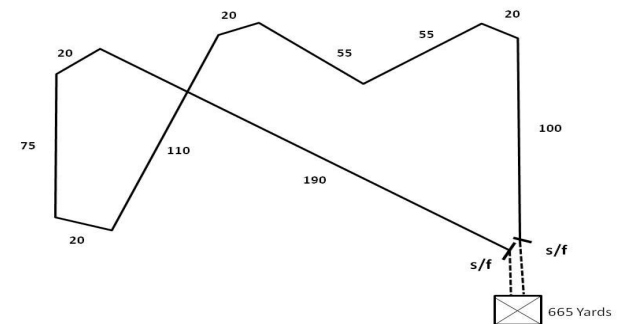
COURSES
