ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Borzoi may be entered in the regular stakes. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club (ILP&PAL included), the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry. If this is your borzoi's first ASFA trial, you must submit a copy of his AKC registration paper, and an ASFA Certification Form or AKC QC Form. If your dog has earned the AKC senior courser, AKC field champion or Canadian field champion title, fill out the "Wavier" portion of the ASFA certification form, & include a copy of the dog's title. Otherwise, fill out the "Certification" portion, which has to be signed by a licensed ASFA judge who has watched your dog coursing with another dog.

Late, incomplete, conditional, unsigned, unpaid entries will NOT be accepted. Owners may substitute for lame or in-season borzoi with another borzoi that they own.

Entries will not be acknowledged by mail.

STAKES OFFERED

Open Stake: Any eligible Borzoi who has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of Record. A photocopy of the Borzoi's registration must be submitted at the Borzoi's first trial along with an ASFA certification, AKC QC or waiver certificate.

Field Champion Stake: Any ASFA Field Champion Borzoi.

Veteran Stake: Any eligible Borzoi whose age exceeds six years, who has met certification requirements. Points earned in this stake are towards the V-FCH or V-LCM titles.

Singles Stake: Any eligible Borzoi including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPS titles from the Singles stake.


CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1 hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. All entries must be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split if entry in any one stake is 20 or more at the time of the draw. Bitches in season and lame Borzoi at Roll Call will be excused and entry fee refunded. Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Borzoi not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched. Hound certification runs will be offered immediately after Roll Call. A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose on the field not competing in the course in progress. All Borzoi run at the owner's sole risk. Please be responsible Borzoi owners and clean up after your dogs and yourselves.


Reversed for finals & Best of Breed

AKC and ASFA trial Best of Breed winners have the opportunity to run off for Best in Event after the ASFA trial is complete.



BCOA reserves the right to alter the course plan if required by weather and/or field conditions prior to or on the day of the trial, which may affect the usability of the field. A battery operated, continuous loop lure machine, with backup equipment, will be used. Lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.

TROPHIES

The David Breaz Perpetual Trophy: A Dannyquest bronze sculpture titled “Leaping Borzoi,” mounted on a walnut base. The name of the winner will be engraved on the base. A commemorative plaque will be given to the owner of the winner. The winner need not be a member of the Borzoi Club of America. This trophy is offered by his friends, in memory of David Breaz, through the Borzoi Club of America, Inc., at its Annual Specialty Show and will be on exhibit at this show. This trophy will remain in the possession of the Borzoi Club of America.

The Rancho Gabriel Memorial Trophy: A mounted bronze sculpture titled “The Coursing Borzoi” by Kathy Lyon, 1973, #14 of 250. The name of the winner will be engraved on the base. The winner need not be a member of the Borzoi Club of America. This trophy is offered by friends of the Gillettes, in appreciation of years of dedication and perseverance of lure coursing, nationally and internationally, and finally American Kennel Club approval, through the Borzoi Club of America, Inc., at its Annual Specialty Show and will be on exhibit at this show. This trophy will remain in the possession of the Borzoi Club of America.

The Charles J. Kubiak Challenge Trophy - A mounted cast metal Borzoi sculpture on a walnut base to be awarded to the Best of Breed winner at the Borzoi Club of America National Specialty ASFA coursing trial. Competition is open to any BCOA member in good standing at the time of the win. It must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive years, for permanent possession and retirement. This trophy is offered by the Friends of Charles J. Kubiak and the Garden State Sighthound Association, through the Borzoi Club of America, Inc. at its annual National Specialty Show and will be on exhibit at the show. This trophy will remain in the possession of the Borzoi Club of America.

BCOA reserves the right to substitute a trophy of equal or higher value. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the Show Chairperson must be advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No award will be mailed.

DIRECTIONS: Travel time is approx. 30 minutes from the host hotel.

GPS/MAP: "99 Glendale Rd., Limestone TN 37681"

Google Maps works well. Verizon has the best cell coverage, but reception on the field may be spotty. There will be signage for the "field entrance."

FROM I-81 (N, E, W) (12 MINS): NEVER USE EXIT 44. Take exit 50 for TN-93 south for 1.8 miles. Continue straight onto TN-81 for 2.2 miles. Right on Cherry Hill Rd for .6 miles. Bear left to Martin Rd. for .9 miles. Right on Glendale for 2.7 miles.

FROM I-26 (S) (40 MINS): Take exit 37 north on TN-107/TN-81 for about 22 miles. Follow signs for TN-81N through Jonesborough. After passing the Marathon, keep an eye out for a sharp right turn, where you'll continue straight onto Pleasant Grove Rd. for .8 miles. Turn right onto Glendale Rd for 3.4 miles.

RV NOTICE: Highly advised that you come in via: I-81 - TN 93 (Exit 50) - TN-81N - Oak Hill Cir (Across from Oak Hill Baptist Church) - Oak Hill Rd - Martin Rd - Glendale Rd

FIELD CONDITIONS: There is some limited shade at the edges of this field. Bring water and plan to provide shade for your dogs in case the shaded areas are already taken.

HOSPITALITY: Morning hospitality will be available. Donations are always appreciated. Lunch will be delivered to the field (around noon), but **MUST** be ordered in advance using the one-stop shop with entries. Lunch is \$10.
