ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, Whippets, and Provisional breeds may be entered in the regular stakes.

Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

DIRECTIONS

READ FIRST → DO NOT totally depend on your GPS device or you may end up in a cow field.

(Starkville is 14 miles southwest of the NYS Thruway off Exit 29)

→ At Exit 28 (mile marker 182—Fonda, Fultonville), Dunkin' Donuts, two truck stops with restaurants, a McDonald's, and several gas stations. It's an easy-off, easy-on exit, and 12 miles from Exit 29, which is our exit.). At Exit 29, there is a gas station/convenience store to the left, then several on the way to Fort Plain on Route 5S.

FROM THE EAST or NORTHEAST: New York State Thruway (I-90) to Exit 29 (mm 194 – Canajoharie, Sharon Springs, Fort Plain, Cooperstown, Oneonta, St. Johnsville). Pay the toll – the big white Beech Nut Foods factory will be on your right, a Betty Beaver's Getty station & small convenience store is on the left. Turn RIGHT at the stop sign onto State Route (SR) 5-S West. Go thru the little traffic light in Canajoharie, and continue on SR 5-S West for about 3 miles to the village of Fort Plain.
