

DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD:

Directions to the field: Watch for Coursing signs to the field. The field is visible from Rt. 15. Located in front of the Plantation Mansion, and on the Main Entrance Road. The main gate on Plantation Drive is open 9-5. Coursing exhibitors must use Gap road (a narrow road Before the Plantation entrance), then Turn right and follow the Gravel road to the field.

Directions from the North:

From Interstate 70 in Frederick, MD: take Route 340/15 South. Bear onto 15S at the split. Leesburg is 24 miles. Follow 15/7 Leesburg bypass to 15 South Oatlands is 6 miles south of Leesburg on Rt. 15. Turn LEFT on to **Gap Road** and proceed to the field on the right. **Gap Rd.** is BEFORE Oatlands this direction. Watch for coursing signs.

From Washington Beltway: take either Route 7 or Dulles Greenway west to Leesburg 15/7 bypass, then exit south on Route 15-South. Follow rest of directions above.

Directions from the South:

Follow Route 15 North toward Leesburg. Oatlands is on the right before Leesburg. Go past the main entrance of Oatlands and TURN RIGHT on the first road, **Gap Road**. This is a narrow dirt road. Follow coursing signs to the field.

For a Limited breed to be eligible, the entry must have one first placement, or two second placement, with competition in the Limited Stake. For a Provisional breed to be eligible, the hound must have received a placement with competition. All points or placements must be earned by the closing date of the event. An eligible hound may be entered in any number of Regional Invitationals. Hounds entered in the Single Stake are not eligible to be entered in Breeder, Kennel, or Bench stakes. ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzois, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes.

Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. Limited stake breeds currently include: purebred Chart Polskis, Galgo Españols, Magyar Agars, Peruvian Inca Orchids, & Portuguese Podengos (Medio, Grande & Pequeno) and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (ILP/PAL included), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry, this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

- OPEN STAKE:** Any eligible Sighthound that has met certification requirements excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.
- FIELD CHAMPION STAKE:** Any ASFA Field Champion.
- VETERAN STAKE:** Any eligible Sighthound that has met certification requirements and is 6 years of age or older (5 years for Irish Wolfhounds; 7 years for Afghans, Saluki, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, and Whippets).
- SINGLES STAKE:** Any eligible Sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles. Each hound runs alone.
- LIMITED STAKE:** Any eligible Sighthound of a Limited breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

NON-REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

- KENNEL STAKE:** For hounds of any individual breeds; an entry shall consist of two hounds, designated at time of entry, in one of the regular stakes being owned and kenneled by the same person.
- BREEDER STAKE:** For any eligible breed which shall have, designated at time of entry, two hounds bred by the same individual.
- BENCH STAKE:** For any eligible sighthound with proof on file with the ASFA of Conformation champion title from the AKC, CKC or both, or a conformation grand champion title from the UKC.
- BEST SINGLE IN EVENT:** Top Single, Saturday * Sunday May compete in single runs on Sunday for Best Single in Event
- BEST IN FIELD WILL NOT BE OFFERED either day**
- BEST in EVENT on Sunday will be offered**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial.

Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.

- Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call.
- Exhibitors are requested not to bring bitches known to be in season to the field
- Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake.
- Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched.
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. The members of PAHC/DASH reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field condition on the day of the trial.
- Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.

Exhibitor Information

The course will be reversed for the finals, runoffs and Best of Breed. The members of PAHC/DASH reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the date of the trial. Exhibitors are requested to not bring bitches known to be in season to the field. There will be a \$5.00 fine assessed for any loose hound not participating in the course. Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee. Bring your own shade and water. Lunch will be available for nominal fee.

Equipment: Type of lure machine: battery-powered continuous-loop system.

Type of lures: highly-visible white plastic strip. Back-up equipment will be available.

Certification: will be available on Saturday after completion of trial if weather, equipment and judges permit. Cost is \$10.00 per hound.

Practice will be offered after certifications with weather, equipment and time permitting. Cost is \$3.00 per run.

DISCLAIMER: Upon entering this trial, the exhibitor agrees to hold harmless PAHC and DASH, its members, and the event location organization (Oatlands) for any injury, loss, or damage sustained by person or hound. 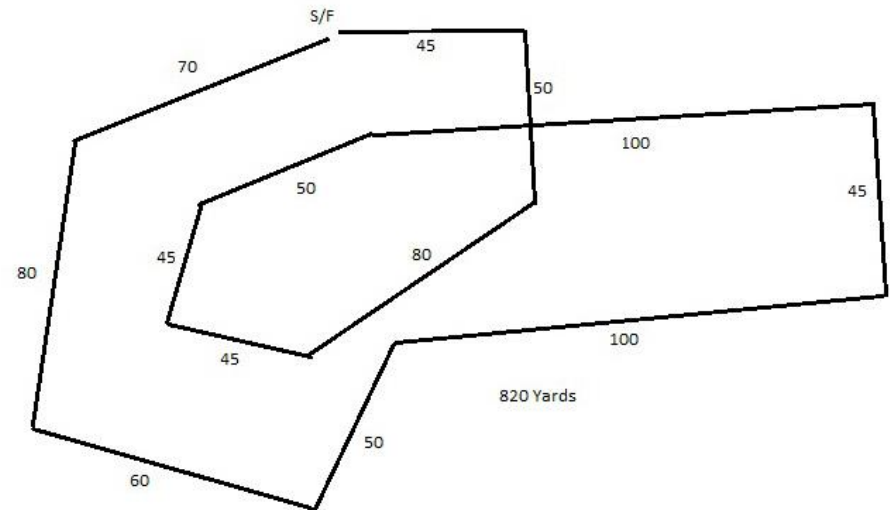

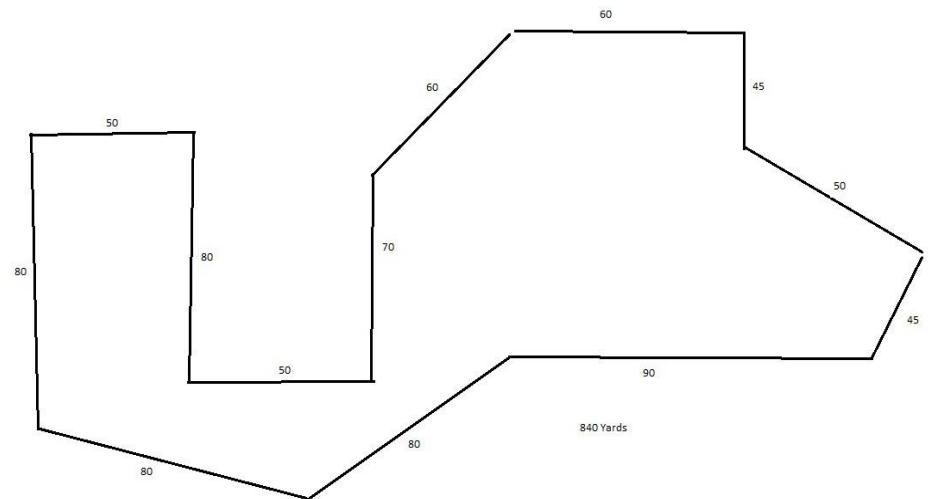
