Notes from Judges Licensing:

We as ASFA judges are looked up to by the exhibitors to provide opinion on the performance of the dogs during our assignments. We are also looked at regarding how we handle situations which may not be favorable to us. In that regard, we should set examples of sportsmanship when another judge does not score a course to our liking.

ASFA requests that all exhibitors show respect to the judge on the field when asking their opinions. Judges are usually located in a space different than the exhibitors and should be looking at all the dogs in the course and not just their own. This is why judges do not judge dogs they own.

We should not make a scene at any trial whether we are judging or not. Respect the judge(s) on the field and their opinions of each course and do not argue in front of other exhibitors.
