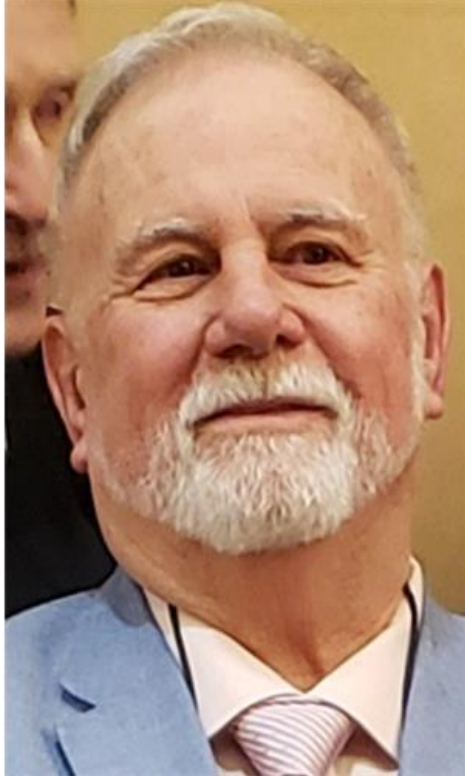

# Understanding **ASFA Points**

ASFA has two sets of points: Title & Bowen.

- Bowen points are for hounds defeated, and this is how the Top 20 is compiled.
- Title points are the points your hound is awarded for placing in its breed, and these points accrue to earn titles.

## **Title points** (Ch VII Sec 1 of the ASFA Running Rules)

The hound awarded 1<sup>st</sup> place gets 4 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place gets 3 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place gets 2 points and 4<sup>th</sup> place gets 1 point for each hound defeated including itself in its stake (flight if the stake is split). Hounds excused, pulled, or given a zero score in the preliminary course do not count towards the points. Hounds dismissed or disqualified in the preliminary do count. Hounds pulled from the final course still count.

So, if there are 5 hounds in stake that all compete in preliminary & final course points would be awarded as follows 1<sup>st</sup> 20 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 15 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 10 points and 4<sup>th</sup> 5 points. Each hound counts even if it does not get a qualifying score (at least 50% of available combined scores, single judge available score is 200 & with two judges the available score is 400).

Now, if we have the same 5 hounds but one of the hounds is excused in the preliminary course the points are counted as only 4 so 1<sup>st</sup> 16 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 12 points, etc. If there are more than one hound pulled, excused, or given a score of zero the points drop accordingly.

To earn an ASFA title (Ch VII Sec 3), you also need to get qualifying 1<sup>st</sup> and/or 2<sup>nd</sup> placements depending on the title. A qualifying placement (Ch VII Sec 3(b)) is earned when a hound defeats at least one placing hound.

## **Best of Breed points** (Ch V Sec 7)

Only hounds that win a BOB run shall be awarded points equal to the points awarded the highest placing hound in that breed which it defeated.

So, if you have 3 Open, 4 FCh & 1 Vet competing in a breed. The winner of each stake received a qualifying score and competes for BOB. If the Open wins the BOB run it now earns the 16 FCh points instead of the 12 Open points not in addition to

the 12 Open points. If only the Open & Vet runoff for BOB with the FCh forfeiting, the winner will still get the FCh points even though it did not run. If BOB is awarded by forfeit the points earned in the stake is what the winner will receive not the highest points if any are available. If there is a single entrant in the stakes and they run off for BOB, the winner will get a qualifying placement in addition to the original 4 points. If there is a BOB run which results in a tie and one or more of the entrants forfeits the winner will get the highest available points since there was a run.

### **Best In Field points** (Ch V Sec 12 (e))

Additional points are awarded to the hound that wins the BIF run. This is determined by the number of hounds which compete in the BIF run. The winner will get 4 points for each hound that runs in BIF added to the points earned in Breed but not to exceed 40 points. So, your hound was the BOB winner earning 16 points then you choose to run them in BIF. There is a total entry of 5 hounds in BIF with your hound ending with the highest score. Your hound would earn an additional 20 points. So, your hound would end with a total of 36 points for winning BIF.

# HALL OF FAME

## *nominations*

### **This is the Time for Hall of Fame Nominations**

Do you have a remarkable hound or person in mind to nominate for the Hall of Fame? Or could you help put together a nomination for one of the top 5 ASFA Lifetime Hounds that is not currently in the Hall of Fame? We want to make sure that we have the information for these hounds before it is lost in the mists of time, especially for those hounds competing 10 or more years ago.

### **Nomination Requirements and Process**

All nominees – hounds and persons - must have been out of the sport for at least 5 years to be considered. Hound nominations are made through the ASFA clubs. Persons are nominated through the Regions. So, to nominate a hound, you will need to work through your club. To nominate a person, you will need to work with your Regional Director. The Hall of Fame Committee will select up to 5 nominated hounds and 3 nominated persons to present for consideration at the 2022 ACoD. The ACoD Delegates will then vote to induct 1 person and up to 3 hounds into the Hall of Fame for 2021.

### **Deadline to Submit Nominations**

The ASFA Hall of Fame nominations for the current year are now open and will remain open through January 31, 2022. They will be voted on at the 2022 Annual Convention of Delegates on March 19, 2022.

The forms and instructions are also reprinted below following the list of previous HOF honorees. **The closing date for submitting nominations is January 31, 2022.**

**The purpose of the ASFA Hall of Fame** is to honor in perpetuity those hounds that have achieved outstanding performances or records in the sport of lure coursing. This fosters the continued remembrance of remarkable individual coursing careers and sets a high standard to help new hounds and owners achieve their goals.

The Hall of Fame shall also honor those individuals who have donated a great part of their life to improve and promote the sport of lure coursing for sighthounds. Since its inception, the sport of lure coursing has continually evolved. That evolution has taken place through the vision and energy of people who should be honored for their efforts on behalf of the sport. We shall endeavor to remember those individuals who have given their time and energy to make lure coursing what it is today. Their commitment serves as an inspiration to those who would, in turn, take the sport to greater heights.

### Hall of Fame Charter Members

The Hall of Fame was instituted in 1998. The 1998 Annual Convention of Delegates elected to the Hall of Fame the first Field Champion of each breed; the first Lure Courser of Merit of each breed; the first AKC conformation champion of each breed to become an ASFA Field Champion; the only three hounds to obtain the Grand Field Champion title; and the following people: Lyle Gillette, Tom Leone, Betz Leone and Gary Forrester. These hounds and individuals are the Charter members of the ASFA Hall of Fame.

## **Procedures for Nominations:**

### **Hounds:**

Any ASFA club may recommend one hound on an annual basis to be considered for the Hall of Fame. Recommendations should be submitted on the form provided for this purpose and signed by a club officer.

Submit two photos of the nominated hound if possible. It is preferred that one photo be a still, standing or "stacked" photo and the other be a running or action photo of the dog.

The form should be submitted to the Hall of Fame Committee Chair no later than the date selected by the committee and published on the ASFA.org website for that year.

The hound should be retired and have not entered a trial in the last five years. To get the correct date of the last trial a hound entered, please contact the ASFA Records Coordinator at [records@asfa.org](mailto:records@asfa.org).

The hound should have great coursing accomplishments, including a long coursing career with a top-winning record, however, great achievement in a short time span will be considered.

The committee will then select ten hounds to be voted on by delegates convening at the ensuing Annual Convention of Delegates (ACoD).

In the event that there are not at least ten hounds nominated by clubs, the Hall of Fame Committee may nominate additional hounds to bring the total to ten. The Committee will first consider hounds previously nominated and not elected, but may also nominate hounds not previously nominated.

Three hounds will be chosen for the Hall of Fame by written ballot. A picture and biographical sketch of each hound elected into the Hall of Fame will be entered into the appropriate historian's album. The Hall of Fame Committee shall award each year at the ACoD certificates for hounds inducted into the ASFA Hall of Fame.

### **Hounds Not Elected:**

If a hound nominated to the Hall of Fame is not elected, it shall automatically be placed on the ballot for the following year. If the hound is not elected in its second year on the ballot, the nomination process must be repeated to place them on the ballot again.

## JUDGES LICENSING REPORT – October 2021

This report is submitted by the Chair of Judges Licensing and is current as of 10/26/2021 =====

### **Notes from Judges Licensing:**

I was informed by Steve Artley that he has resigned as a judge.

I want to take this opportunity to thank Steve for his service as an ASFA judge since 1988.

Several Judges Handbooks which were mailed out have been returned by the postal service. Please verify your mailing address if you did not receive your copy.

It has been brought to the attention of the Board through a letter of irregularity about judges helping to resight dogs in singles and LCI. As judges, we are to evaluate and score the course as it is run. While nothing states that a judge cannot or should not assist a dog to get resighted, per the rules, if the dog is unsighted due to course conditions or lure operator error, the judge may stop the course and either run the entire course or start from the point where the condition occurred. Refer to Chapter III, Section 8 for exact guidance on calling a no course.

I want to remind everyone that if you assist one dog or call a no course, you should extend the assistance or calling a no course to any dog that gets unsighted during the day **in similar circumstances**. Also, when you mark down one dog for failing to follow the lure, each dog that also fails to follow should be marked with a similar score depending on how far off or how much assistance was afforded.

The same holds true for singles and LCI dogs that do not start immediately or runs back to the handler after a short distance. If one dog is afforded the opportunity to restart or have the handler run with the dog for a short distance, all dogs that fail to start should be afforded this opportunity and scored similarly.

**Consistency** should be the goal of all judging.

***Notes from Judges Licensing:***

All judges should familiarize themselves with Chapter 5, Section 12(e).

(e) Additional ASFA championship points will be awarded to the hound winning BIF, determined by the number of hounds actually defeated in the BIF run. No more than 40 total points can be earned at a trial by that hound. The hound that wins Best in Field will also be credited with a first placement in a stake. The highest-scoring hound with a qualifying score will be declared the Best in Field on that day.

Apparently, there have been exhibitors who have questioned judges about points awarded and received multiple answers.

## 2021 ASFA National Greyhound Specialty

The 16<sup>th</sup> running of the ASFA National Greyhound Specialty was held on Saturday, November 20 and hosted by the Southeastern Greyhound Club (SEGC) at the beautiful 8,000 acre Bouckaert Farm near Fairburn, Georgia, just south of Atlanta. Our judges were Kathy Nelson of Lake Crystal, Minnesota and Dana Jensen of Lake St. Louis, Missouri.

The ASFA National Greyhound Specialty was originally conceived by the late Greyhound sportsman Mike Lorenzo as a day-long celebration of the Greyhound breed. To that end, the Specialty has always featured a mid-day

conformation competition, held between the preliminary and final courses of the lure trial, and judged by a judge with longstanding experience actually watching Greyhounds run in competition. This year the conformation judge was one of our lure coursing judges, Kathy Nelson. After the lure trial, straight “fun runs” on drag lure were offered to Greyhounds not entered in the lure trial.

As always, SEGC exercised the option of running entered hounds in braces rather than trios for the Specialty. Drag lure was used on the large, open 860 yard galloping course plan. Greyhounds were entered in two of the offered stakes – Open and Singles.

The winner of the Open stake and thus Best of Breed in the Specialty was Bodhi, registered name NB’s Californian, a former racing Greyhound owned by Chris DeNegriz of Boiling Springs, Pennsylvania. The winner of the Singles stake was Grimm, registered name Hogs Heath, also a retired racing Greyhound, owned by Lydia Murray of Athens, Georgia. In the conformation competition, the Best in Show winner, from the Puppy class, was the Canadian-bred (by Brandi Quinn) Greyhound Winnie, registered name Finest Hour, owned by John and Laura Parker of Moreland, Georgia.

A trophy table displaying the perpetual trophies offered for each stake and the “keeper” presentation blanket to be won by the Best of Breed winner was expertly set up by SEGC member (and Huntmaster) Beth Kuhn. Welcome bags filled with all manner of goodies for Greyhounds and their humans were organized by SEGC member Lynn Sawyer, who arranged for an amazing array of donated prizes, including a traditional leather fishtail collar for the Specialty winner. A complimentary commemorative lapel pin bearing the Specialty logo was given to everyone attending the Specialty.

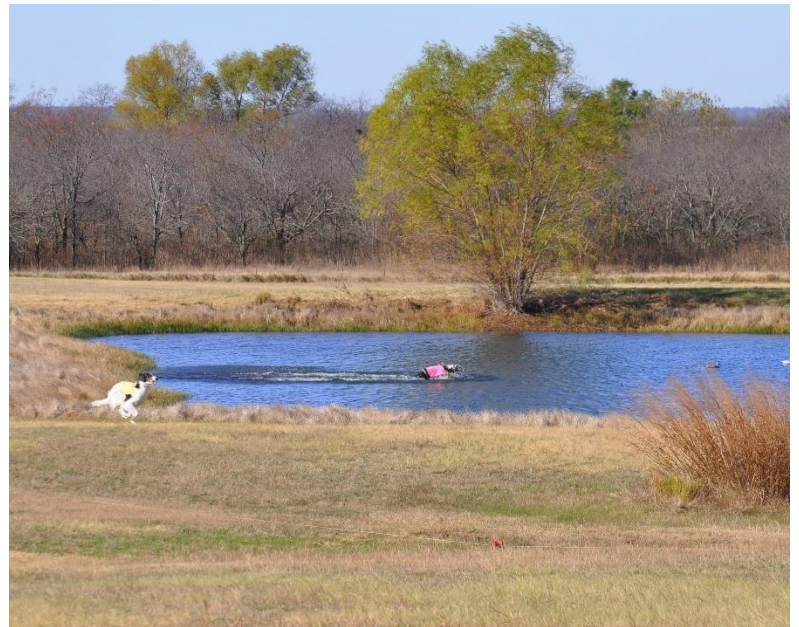

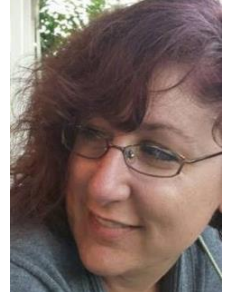
