

Day of Trial Entries close: 10:00 AM at the Trial Secretary's table (or 45 minutes after Ibizan conformation Best of Breed is awarded, whichever is later) **ROLL CALL:** begins 15 minutes after entries close.

Incomplete, unsigned, conditional or unpaid entries will not be accepted. No email or fax entries accepted. Entries will not be acknowledged by mail; they may be acknowledged by email.

ELIGIBLE BREED AND REGISTRY: Only purebred Ibizan Hounds may be entered in the regular stakes. All Entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club (ILP and PAL included), the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA recognized foreign registry or an ASFA board approved registry.

REGULAR STAKES:

OPEN STAKE: Open to all eligible Ibizan Hounds, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record. First time entrants must have met the certification requirements and include a certification form and copy of registration. FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Open to Ibizan Hounds that are ASFA Field Champions

VETERAN STAKE: Open to Ibizan Hounds whose age is at least six years old and have met the certification requirements.

SINGLE STAKE: Any eligible Ibizan Hound including those disgualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible for Best of Breed. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake.

NON-REGULAR STAKES***

BREEDER STAKE: For two Ibizan Hounds, designated at time of entry, bred by the same individual. Singles Stake is ineligible for this non-regular stake. KENNEL STAKE: For two Ibizan Hounds, designated at time of entry, owned and kenneled by the same individual. Singles Stake is ineligible for this non-regular stake. **BENCH CHAMPION STAKE:** For any hound eligible to enter a regular stake, that is an AKC and/or CKC champion, and/or UKC Grand Champion. A copy of the hound's championship certificate must accompany each Stake entry. **PERFORMANCE TITLED:** For any hound eligible to enter a regular stake (excluding Singles), that is an AKC, CKC or UKC performance/companion title holder of record (excluding Field Trial Titles). A copy of the hound's title certificate must accompany each entry.

*** If a tie exists after the final runs then the dog(s) with the highest FINAL score will be declared the winner. IF the final score is tied then the dog(s) with the highest Preliminary score will be declared the winner.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.

2. Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.

3. Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds will be excused at roll call, Hounds with breed disqualifications will also be excused, unless entered in Singles Stake.

4. Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered; hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake.

5. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched.

6. Hound certification runs will not be offered. (AKC QC Runs are being held on Friday, Sept. 14. Purina Farms ... AKC QC's can be used for ASFA Certification purposes ...email any questions to the Trial Secretary)

7. Battery powered continuous loop machines will be used. Lures will consist of white plastic bags. Backup equipment will be available.

8. The course will be reversed for the finals and again for the BOB run-offs. Course subject to change based upon condition of the field and weather.

9. The Field Committee reserves the right to alter the course diagram as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

10. Please bring your own shade and water.

11. No one, except Field Committee members, will be allowed on the field without the expressed permission of the Field Chairman.

12. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be excused from the field for the day.

13. IHCUS assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after the Trial.

♥ If you have ANY questions about what stakes/tests to enter your dog, e-mail the field trial secretary <u>natlcsecretary@ihcus.org</u>

♥ Make sure to bring shade and water for your hounds

♥ All hounds finishing their QC titles are eligible to run in Open BUT IT IS ONLY ENCOURAGED if they've run more than just the QC with another hound, and have run cleanly without coursing another hound or interfering in any way

There will be a port-a-john on site.

♥ Please park in the parking lot located prior to the bridge

♥ Make sure to pay attention to the running order, your dog's colors, and to the paddock master – if your hound is ready and waiting, when it's his turn to run, the trial goes smoother for everyone. Any hound that is more than five minutes late in getting to the line for their course may be excused from competition for the day.

♥ If you are new to the sport, grab someone and ask questions! We're always happy to help "newbies" learn the ropes!

Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

♥ No cigarette smoking on or near the field.

P DO NOT TURN DOGS LOOSE IN ANY OF THE FENCED AREAS

♥ We will NOT be breaking for the all-breed conformation Groups or Best in Show.

ATTENTION: WE WILL BE SHARING THE FIELD WITH THE GREYHOUNDS! More details to follow.

COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Judges, workers, and exhibitors will be required to wear a solid facial covering that completely covers the nose and mouth.

1. All members of the Field Committee and Lure Operators will wear facial coverings.

2. All participants will wear facial coverings and practice social distancing.

3. No food will be served. Please bring your own food, water, and shade for yourself and your dogs.

4. We ask that all participants park a safe distance away from one another.

5. Roll Call will be performed as usual, with everyone socially distanced. The Inspection Committee will wear gloves and facial coverings. Participants with female dogs will be asked to wipe their dogs and show the wiping material to the Inspection Committee.

6. Portable toilets will have their doors propped open when not in use.

7. The Huntmaster will stand six feet from the participants after inspecting blankets and slip leads.

8. At the starting line, dogs will stand six feet apart.

9. Running orders will be posted as usual, but please socially distance. If you have a smartphone, please take a photo of the running order and results and do not linger near the postings. Running orders & results will also be posted on the IHCUS Facebook Page.

10. There will not be self-serve ribbons at this event.

These procedures may change, depending on the requirements by Purina Farms and the State of Missouri. Thank you for your flexibility!

ALL ENTRANTS MUST ADHERE TO ALL COVID-19 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

LIMITED EVENT ATTENDANCE: Facilities and events will operate at limited capacity based on St. Louis area guidelines. We will continue to update these as local guidelines allow. For now, spectators are not allowed at events. (Capacity constraints will be adjusted based on current COVID-19 guidelines.)

ENTRY/EXIT POINTS: Names of registered participants and guests will appear on a Check-in list provided to security to allow for entry onto the property.

PHYSICAL DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS: All event participants and guests must follow appropriate social distancing restrictions of six feet or more from others and avoid physical contact with anyone else, including other pets. Floor markings and signage will continue to serve as reminders to maintain social distancing.

FACE COVERING REQUIRED: In alignment with CDC guidelines, fully vaccinated guests and employees will not be required to wear masks while on property but will be encouraged to do so indoors. For unvaccinated individuals, masks will need to continue being worn indoors and outdoors while on the property, unless actively eating or drinking. Face coverings are also encouraged for any guests (if applicable) ages 2-4. If for some medical reason you are unable to wear a face covering, we will determine if there is another alternative for you [and others] to safely enjoy Purina Farms. In line with our culture of trust and mutual respect, we will not be requiring proof of vaccination. We do, however, expect everyone to be honest with each other.

ADVANCE CLEANING PROTOCOLS: Common use items and equipment, including drinking fountains and dog watering stations, will not be available for the time being. Restrooms will be frequently cleaned and disinfected.

CHILDREN: Any children on property must always be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times. Also, see face covering guideline above. Purina Farms shall reduce capacity and control the maximum number of event participants and guests in its facilities to 25% of the normally permitted occupancy, in accordance with the current Guidance per the City of St. Louis: https://www.stlouis-mo.gov/government/departments/health/communicable- disease/covid-19/documents/upload/Large-Venues.pdf
