**From 1-55 North or South:** take Exit 37 for Livingston/New Douglas, go East approximately 5 miles into the town of New Douglas, turn left (North) onto Main Street (at the stop sign), then in 1/4-mile turn right (East) onto Sorento Road. Go approximately 5 miles and turn left onto Griffiths Road. Field is 3/4 mile on the right, just past the county rock pile (which is on the left).

**From 1-70 East or West:** take Exit 36 for Pocahontas and go North approximately 4 miles to IL-140 (first stop sign). Turn left (West) on IL-140, go 1 mile then turn right (North) onto Old Ripley Road. Follow Old Ripley Road 6.3 miles to stop sign, turn left (West) onto New Douglas Avenue. Go 0.4 miles, turn right (North) onto Griffiths Road. Field is 3/4 mile on the right, just past the county rock pile (which is on the left).

The trial is open to all basenjies 12 months of age or older that are individually registered/listed with the AKC registration or as a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) basenjies.

### **Additional Information:**

- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the trial.
- Each dog requires an entry form.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official ASFA Entry Form.
- Bitches in season, lame dogs and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused. Entries will be refunded.
- Hound substitutions are allowed after the pre-entry closing date.
- Spayed, monorchid, cryptorchid, and neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- **A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.**
- Battery powered; continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve their hound.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the ASFA/BCOA/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- The event-hosting club or Isen Farm, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc. assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.

### **STAKES OFFERED**

#### **REGULAR STAKES**

**OPEN STAKE:** Open to all eligible basenjis, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record. First time entrants must have met the certification requirements and include a certification form and copy of registration.

**FIELD CHAMPION STAKE:** Open to basenjis that are ASFA Field Champions.

**VETERAN STAKE:** Open to basenjis whose age is at least seven years and have met the certification requirements.

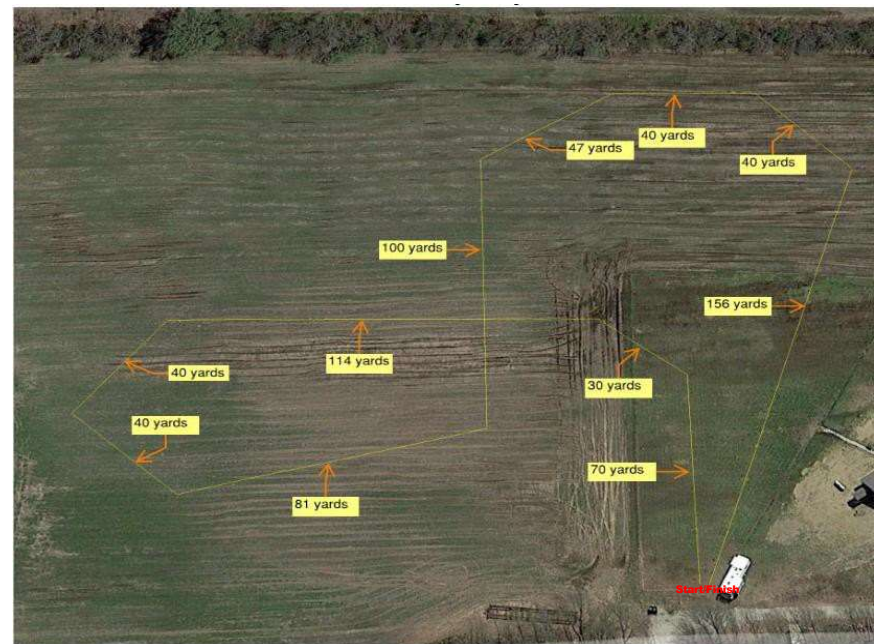
**SINGLES STAKE:** Any eligible basenjis including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible for Best of Breed.

#### **NON-REGULAR STAKES**

**BREEDER STAKE:** For two basenjis designated at time of entry, bred by the same individual. Singles Stake is ineligible for this non-regular stake.

**KENNEL STAKE:** For basenjis, designated at time of entry, owned and kenneled by the same individual. Singles Stake is ineligible for this non-regular stake.

Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more. Hound certification runs will not be offered.



Course Plan: 758 yards

The course will be reversed for finals. The club reserves the right to alter the course plans as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
