CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All Scottish Deerhounds must be one year or older on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.
- All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with AKC (including PAL and ILP), FCI, an ASFA recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry.
- A photocopy of an acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications are only eligible for the singles stake.
- Bitches in season and hounds lame at roll call will be barred from competing and their entry fees refunded. *No bitches in season on the field.*
- Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. No refund will be issued.
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- Battery or gas powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of black or white plastic strips and/or skins. Back up equipment will be available.
- The members of the field committee reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
- There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose hound not taking part in a course in progress.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to ASFA/SDCA/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.

Stakes Offered (Regular Stakes)

Open: Any eligible Scottish Deerhound that has met certification requirements excluding ASFA Field Champions of Record.

Field Champion: Any Scottish Deerhound ASFA Field Champion.

Veteran: Any eligible Scottish Deerhound that has met certification requirements that is at least 6 years of age.

Singles: Any eligible Scottish Deerhound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible to run for Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Stakes Offered

Breeder: An entry shall consist of two Scottish Deerhounds bred or co-bred by the same individual. Hounds must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran). Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Breeder Stake Award. A hound may be part of only one Kennel Stake Entry. Single Stake entrants are not eligible for this stake.

Kennel: An entry shall consist of two Scottish Deerhounds owned and living with the same person. Hounds must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran). Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Kennel Stake Award. A hound may be part of only one Kennel Stake Entry. Single Stake entrants are not eligible for this stake.

GENERATION STAKE: An entry shall consist of a stud dog OR a brood bitch and one dog produced by that dog. Both must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran or Singles) but need not be owned or bred by the same person. Each Stud Dog or Brood Bitch can only be paired with one chosen offspring; however an offspring can be paired with either one or both parents. Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Generation Stake Award.

BENCH CHAMPION STAKE: For any hound eligible to enter a regular stake, that is an AKC, CKC, or ASFA-approved international show champion of record. A copy of the hound's championship certificate must accompany each Stake entry. The ASFA does not recognize the UKC show champion as of Jan. 1, 2022.
