ELIGIBILITY


Only purebred Borzoi may enter this trial. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (ILP & PAL included), FCI, UKC or an ASFA recognized foreign or an ASFA approved registry. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry. All Borzoi must be certified prior to entry closing date (12 noon EST, Wednesday, April 8th, 2026). If this is the first trial for your Borzoi (and you are not entering in Singles), the judge-signed certification form or waiver (with proof of title) as well as a copy of the AKC registration certificate MUST accompany your entry.

Late, incomplete, conditional, unsigned, unpaid entries will NOT be accepted. Owners may substitute for lame or in-season borzoi with another borzoi that they own.

Entries will not be acknowledged by mail.

770 Yards
Reversed for finals and Best of Breed



BCOA reserves the right to alter the course plan if required by weather and/or field conditions prior to or on the day of the trial, which may affect the usability of the field. A battery operated, continuous loop lure machine, with backup equipment, will be used. Lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.

No hound certification runs will be offered.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. All entries must be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split if entry in any one stake is 20 or more at the time of the draw. Bitches in season and lame Borzoi at Roll Call will be excused and entry fee refunded. Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. Borzoi not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched. Entries will not be refunded for hounds scratched. A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose on the field not competing in the course in progress. All Borzoi run at the owner's sole risk. Please be responsible Borzoi owners and clean up after your dogs and yourselves.

STAKES OFFERED

Open Stake: Any eligible Borzoi who has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of Record. A photocopy of the Borzoi's registration must be submitted at the Borzoi's first trial along with an ASFA certification, AKC QC or waiver certificate.

Field Champion Stake: Any ASFA Field Champion Borzoi.

Veteran Stake: Any eligible Borzoi whose age exceeds six years, who has met certification requirements. Points earned in this stake are towards the V-FCH or V-LCM titles.

Singles Stake: Any eligible Borzoi including those disqualified to run in other states. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and TCPX titles from the Singles stake.

Non-Regular Stakes

BREEDER STAKE: An entry shall consist of two hounds bred or co-bred by the same individual. Hounds must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran). Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Breeder Stake Award.

KENNEL STAKE: An entry shall consist of two hounds owned and living with the same person. Hounds must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran). Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Kennel Stake Award.

*Please Note: For Breeder & Kennel Stake: entries may consist of the identical pairing of dogs, but each dog may only be entered once in each stake. Hounds are named at the time of entry.

GENERATION STAKE: An entry shall consist of a stud dog OR a brood bitch and one dog produced by that dog. Both must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran) but need not be owned or bred by the same person. Each Stud Dog or Brood Bitch can only be paired with one chosen offspring; however an offspring can be paired with either one or both parents. Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Generation Stake Award.

BENCH CHAMPION STAKE: For any hound eligible to enter a regular stake, that is an AKC, CKC, or ASFA-approved international show champion of record. A copy of the hound's championship certificate must accompany each Stake entry. The ASFA does not recognize the UKC show champion as of Jan. 1, 2022.

This trophy is offered by his friends, in memory of David Breaz, through the Borzoi Club of America, Inc., at its Annual Specialty Show and will be on exhibit at this show. This trophy will remain in the possession of the Borzoi Club of America.

The Rancho Gabriel Memorial Trophy: A mounted bronze sculpture titled "The Coursing Borzoi" by Kathy Lyon, 1973, #14 of 250. The name of the winner will be engraved on the base. The winner need not be a member of the Borzoi Club of America. This trophy is offered by friends of the Gillettes, in appreciation of years of dedication and perseverance of lure coursing, nationally and internationally, and finally American Kennel Club approval, through the Borzoi Club of America, Inc., at its Annual Specialty Show and will be on exhibit at this show. This trophy will remain in the possession of the Borzoi Club of America.

The Charles J. Kubiak Challenge Trophy - A mounted cast metal Borzoi sculpture on a walnut base to be awarded to the Best of Breed winner at the Borzoi Club of America National Specialty ASFA coursing trial. Competition is open to any BCOA member in good standing at the time of the win. It must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive years, for permanent possession and retirement. This trophy is offered by the Friends of Charles J. Kubiak and the Garden State Sighthound Association, through the Borzoi Club of America, Inc. at its annual National Specialty Show and will be on exhibit at the show. This trophy will remain in the possession of the Borzoi Club of America.

All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the Show Chairperson must be advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No award will be mailed.

Head east on Raynor Pkwy towards S 36th St,
Turn right onto S 36th St, continue on 36th St for .6 mi
Turn left onto NE-370 E, follow NE-370 for 1.5 mi.
Use the right lane to take the ramp onto US-75 South, continue on US-75 for 15.6 mi.
Turn right on NE-1 W, continue on NE-1 for 12 miles
Turn left at fairground entrance, field will be straight ahead
