Due to unforeseen circumstances, the club may substitute committee members as needed.

INSPECTION (8:30-9:00 AM) & ROLL CALL: (9:00 AM)

Each entry will be inspected for breed disqualifications (sighthounds only), lameness, fitness to compete, and bitches in season.

- Being inspected satisfies roll call. Hounds/dogs not present at roll call will be scratched and entry fee will not be refunded.
- If the inspection committee finds any dog to be lame, unfit to safely compete or a bitch in season, that dog shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded. Bitches in season should be removed from the trial site. Sighthounds found to have breed disqualifications may either withdraw from the trial (entry fee will be refunded) or may move to Singles.

AWARDS

- Ribbons or rosettes will be offered for all placements:
1st = blue, 2nd = red, 3rd = yellow, 4th = white, **Next Best Qualifier (NBQ)** = green,
High Scoring Single = navy/gold, **Best of Breed** = purple/gold, **Best in Field** = red/white/blue
- LCI Best of Variety: There will be three Best of Variety awards: one for each LCI variety (Large, Small, Sighthound Mix). The highest combined score wins. If there is a tie, it will be broken using the highest score from prelims or finals, (not including runoff scores). If there is still a tie, the award will be decided by a coin toss.
- Each dog that earns a **new ASFA title** at our trial will receive a New Title ribbon. Please share your new titles at ribbons.
- Other prizes may be offered by MCA and Friends of MCA.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRIES Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhound, Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes. Provisional breeds may be entered in the Provisional Stake or the Singles Stake.

Provisional breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound.

Stakes Offered

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record that has not met the certification requirements.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Afghan Hounds, Ibizans, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets whose age shall be at least seven years. That has obtained an ASFA certification, AKC QC, or other qualifying waivers prior to the closing date. A copy of the certificate **MUST** be submitted with the entry forms. Points go toward V-FCh or V-LCM titles.

PROVISIONAL STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Provisional breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

SINGLES STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Provisional breeds are not eligible for these titles.

Best in Field will be offered both Saturday and Sunday.

LURE CHASING INSTINCT (LCI) STAKE: Open to NON sighthounds and sighthound mixes. Entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, possess a CRN from the SPDBS. Or, dogs without a recognized registry number may obtain an ASFA identification number for a \$10 registration fee at time of entry. Small Open: for dogs 17.5" or less at the withers and / or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs who have not achieved the title of LCC.

Small Excellent: for dogs 17.5" or less at the withers and/or brachycephalic dogs who have achieved the title of LCC.

Small Veteran: for dogs 17.5" or less at the withers and/or brachycephalic dogs over the age of 7 years.

Large Open: for dogs over 17.5" at the withers who have not achieved the title of LCC.

Large Excellent: is for dogs over 17.5" at the withers who have achieved the title of LCC.

Large Veteran: for dogs over 17.5" at the withers who are over the age of 7 years.

SIGHTHOUND MIX Open: for dogs with a sighthound breed in its background who have not achieved the title of LCC.

SIGHTHOUND MIX Excellent: for dogs with sighthound breed in its background who have achieved the title of LCC.

SIGHTHOUND MIX Veteran: for dogs with sighthound breed in its background over the age of 7 years. When running as a stake within a regular ASFA trial, Small will run 50% of the ASFA course as laid out for the sighthounds up to a maximum of 400 yards. All other stakes will run the full ASFA laid out course length.

Conditions of Entry (applies to all stakes)

- Hounds/dogs must be one year of age or older on day of trial.
- Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any stake is 20 or more.
- Females in season, lame hounds/dogs and those that are unfit to course will be excused at roll call.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications that are entered in regular breed stakes will be excused at roll call.
- Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid without breed disqualifications may be entered in regular hound breed stakes.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter Singles Stake.
- Hounds/dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched without refund.
- All hounds/dogs will be run twice unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- All hounds/dogs will run in trios if possible, or braces (except in Singles and LCI stakes).
- A separate entry form is required for each hound/dog for each day.

Other Information

- Battery powered continuous loop lure machine will be used. Backup equipment will be available.
- Lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.
- Exhibitors are requested to not bring bitches known to be in season to the field.
- There will be a \$5.00 fine assessed for any loose hound not participating in the course.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee.
- The field is partially fenced.
- Children must be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.

COURSE PLANS & EQUIPMENT

- Trial will be held on the **North Field**, which is in the NW corner of the grounds.
- The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.
- Course will be reversed for finals.
- Generator powered battery, continuous loop equipment. Back up equipment will be available.
- The field committee reserves the right to alter the course as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

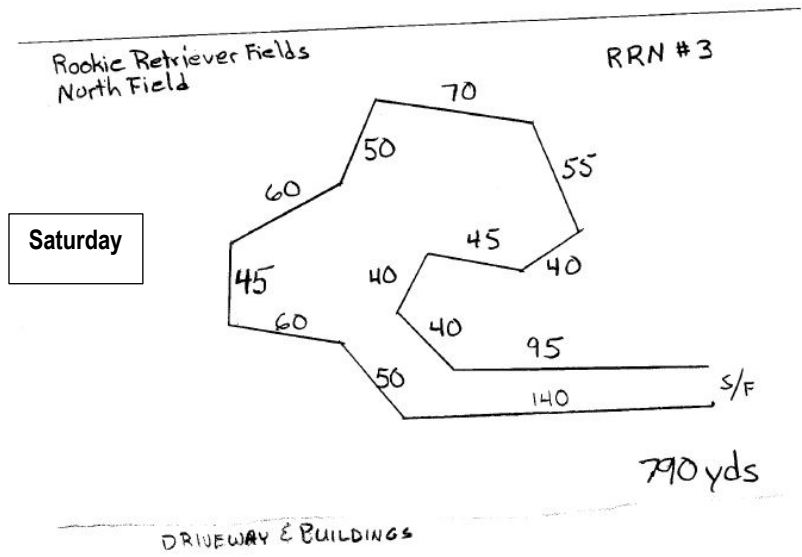

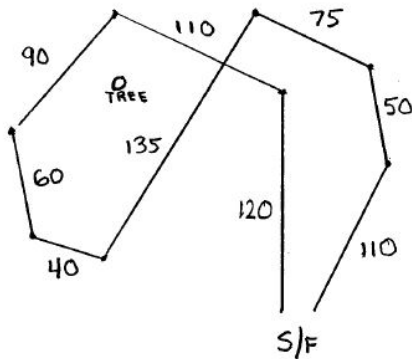

HOW TO ENTER

- Entry: mail completed entry form and payment to the Trial Secretary. Do NOT send entries "signature required". Electronic entries are not accepted.
- Gate entry: bring entry form and payment to the event before close of entries.
- Checks should be made payable to: Minnesota Coursing Association.
- If you have questions about how to enter, contact the Trial Secretary.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Separate entry forms and entry fees are required for each dog.
2. A fee of \$40.00 will be assessed for any returned checks.
3. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, or unpaid entries will not be accepted.
4. The Club and/or Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form.
5. Hounds must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for dogs that hold up the trial.
6. Field Trial Chairman may excuse, or levy & collect a penalty fee of \$5 from the owner (or duly authorized agent) of any hound that is loose on the field and not in competition at the time.
7. Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds by the Field Committee. Children must be under the control of their parents or guardian at all times.
8. Only the lure operator, huntmaster, judges and handlers of the course in progress will be permitted near the lure operating equipment.

REFUNDS

MCA issues entry fee refunds for dogs that are in season or lame. If your dog comes in season or becomes lame before the trial and you will not be attending the trial for these reasons, you must inform the Field Trial Secretary BEFORE roll call to request a refund.

ROUTES TO THE LOCATION

Rookie Retriever Grounds is located 30 miles west of Minneapolis, MN. It is accessible from I-94 & I-494 as well as several US & state highways.

SITE INFORMATION

- **No RV parking available.**
- **Rookie Retriever Grounds requires each person coming onto the grounds to sign a waiver and release from liability. Please follow [this link](#) to the waiver and sign electronically before arriving for the trial. You will note that there are references to the use of firearms in the waiver; this is because the grounds are most often used for sporting dog activities.**
- Bring shade and water. There is limited shade so you may want canopies/sunshades.
- Porta-potty onsite. **Do not** put doggy bags or any other type of waste into the porta-potty!
- Everyone must clean up after their dog. **There will not be a trash can onsite; plan to take home your own trash.** Do not leave trash on the ground.
- Please only drive & park in designated areas. Do not drive across dams or out onto points. Speed limit on the grounds is 5 MPH.
- Do not enter the kennel building or pole buildings. No dogs near the house, kennel building, or pole buildings.
- This is private property; please respect the grounds so we can use it in the future.

FOOD

MCA will host a potluck lunch on Saturday and Sunday. Please watch our Facebook group for details and plan to bring a dish to share, bearing in mind there is no electricity available to plug in crockpots. Free will donations is/are always welcome. Fast-food options are 15-20 minutes away.

CAMPING

There is no overnight camping allowed on the Rookie Retriever Grounds.
