Ribbons or rosettes will be offered for all placements, 1st (blue),
2nd (red), 3rd (yellow), 4th (white), NBQ (green), High Scoring
Single (navy/gold), Best of Breed (purple/gold). Other prizes may
be offered by MGA and friends of MGA.

Substitutions will be accepted for lame or in-season hounds.

Make checks payable to "MGA" in US funds. Do NOT send entries "signature
required". Entries will NOT be acknowledged by mail. Late, incomplete, or unpaid
entries will not be accepted. Entries will be acknowledged by e mail if a legible e-mail
address is provided on the entry form. There will be a \$25 fee for any returned check.

Eligible Breeds & Registry

Only purebred Silken Windhounds and must be individually
registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (ILP/PAL
included), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized
foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from
the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted
with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is
waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

Regular Stakes Offered

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible Silken Windhound, excluding ASFA Field
Champions of record that has met the certification
requirements.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any Silken Windhound ASFA Field Champion of
record.

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible Silken Windhound that has met the certification
requirements and whose age is at least six years. Points go toward V-FCh or
V-LCM titles.


SINGLE STAKE: Any eligible Silken Windhound including those disqualified
to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed
or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the
Singles stake. Provisional breeds are not eligible for these titles.

Conditions of Entry

All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial

- Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry
in any regular stake is 20 or more
- Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed
disqualifications will be excused at roll call. Spayed, neutered,
monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications
may be entered. Hounds with breed disqualifications are not
eligible to enter except in the Single Stake
- Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in
the Single Stake and all LCI Stakes), unless excused, dismissed or
disqualified.

Course Plans



- Course will be reversed for finals, run-offs and BOB. The field is not fenced; adequate Shade and cool/drinking water should be provided by the participants.
- MGA reserves the right to alter course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the trial.
- Gas powered, continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white or black plastic.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose hound on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any handler not cleaning up after their hound.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds by the Field Committee. Children MUST be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.
- Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judges and Handlers of the hounds running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.
- All attempts will be made to separate hounds that have the same owner and live in the same household or being handled by the same person. These entries MUST be submitted together to qualify.
- All dogs run at owners' sole risk. The hosting clubs and property owners, their agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors and handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
- Garbage cans will be onsite for food, dog poop etc. Please respect this field and pick up after yourself. **DO NOT LEAVE** unwanted items such as busted canopies, large trash, etc. Take that with you!
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entries will be refunded. These are the only reasons that pre-entries will be refunded after the pre-entry closing date.

HOW TO ENTER

Scanned/E-mailed entries are acceptable. However, payment **MUST** be made at the time of sending entries using the payment option on the Michigan Gazehound Association website. The email payment confirmation you receive from PayPal can be forwarded to the FTS as proof of payment.

MAILED entries may be paid by either a check in US Funds or by using the payment button at the Michigan Gazehound Association Website. Online entries are also accepted via the AKC entry forms for sighthounds at the Michigan Gazehound Association website. Payment can be made after submitting your online entries.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

If you have **NOT** provided payment by roll call on the day of trial, your entry will be considered conditional and not accepted.
